Music SCHOOL

Playing a musical instrument provides all people the opportunity to break out of their daily routines to occupy a different part of their brains. In 2023, our classrooms once again came alive with music, creating a transformative atmosphere of inspiration as students started new routines.

As North America's second largest acoustic music school, more than

1,300 students engaged with Swallow Hill instructors and curriculum to strengthen their musical roots.



Music classes and private instruction provide an outlet for creativity and expression, reduces stress, improve brain function, and are a source of joy and community.

Our 49 instructors teach a wide variety of instruments and genres to students of all ages and experiences levels. The group setting allows for students to connect with their fellow students and teachers in a welcoming setting that supports a myriad of learning styles.

Adult students embraced getting out of their comfort zones with beginning singing lessons, and mastering the fundamentals of guitar, bass, piano, banjo, mandolin, and more through our core instrument curriculum. As the pieces come together on their individual instruments, many students graduate to ensembles, where they experience assembling a band in genres like bluegrass, jazz, and rock.



In addition to this growth in our group classes, we taught private lessons to 731 students.

Our onsite Little Swallows classes, meanwhile, introduce musical skills to children ages 1-4 through games, activities, and songs. This is done in a fun setting that allows students to bond with their parents and guardians through group activities.

We believe music education should be accessible to all. In 2023 we followed through on that by serving 49 students who received tuition assistance.

In total, over \$24,000 was given out in Tuition Assistance.

Audiences explored new artists with a curated lineup that was organized to ignite passion, provide a platform for self-expression, and help listeners delve into uncharted musical territories. Artists like Carsie Blanton, The Magnetic Fields, Andy Grammer, Jews Do Jews, Dakota Blonde, and Masters of Hawaiian Music: George Kahumoku Jr., Sonny Lim, and Herb Ohta, hosted sold-out shows and wowed audiences with unique melodies.

In addition, we welcomed more than fifty returning artists to reconnect with new and existing fans throughout the Denver Metro area. Their art continues to create an atmosphere of community through engaging stories, soulful melodies, and spontaneous moments of humor and vulnerability. Swallow Hill continues to exceed venue status into an environment for self-expression that forges connections.



What better way to deepen our roots than contribute to the musical education of Denver's youngest music lovers? Our Little Swallows early childhood education classes reached new heights in 2023, pointing to a bright future for our flagship community outreach program.

Little Swallows introduces preschool-aged children to the world of music making by using songs, creative movement, rhymes, percussion instruments, and other fun activities.

"The time that we share with Swallow Hill is just beautiful," shares Louisa Martinez Valdez, Assistant

Program Director at Westwood Early Learning Center, a branch of Mile High Early Learning Center. "I'm so happy that children are able to participate in these classes."

In praising Little Swallows instructor Lily Conrad, Louisa explains how the curriculum ties into larger educational goals. "She provides activities and music that enhance learning skills.

The activities address the four Colorado Academic Standards for preschool music: expression, creation, theory, and aesthetic valuation."

Music THERAPY



We've always known music is good for our soul, and in recent decades music therapy has emerged as an established healthcare profession that uses music to address physical, emotional, cognitive, and social needs of individuals of all ages.*

Music therapy is administered by trained, board-certified professionals who have been educated at an approved music therapy program. At Swallow Hill we provide music therapy in group and one-on-one settings, both onsite and out in the community.

Swallow Hill's music therapy programs help people throughout our community connect physically, emotionally, and mentally through music.

"The residents really love the musical programming and when you add the therapy aspect of it, it takes the experience to the next level,"

Terri Suryn, Senior Programmer at Wind Crest Senior Living says of Swallow Hill's long-running music therapy program.

"Music therapy brings out people who are not normally involved!" she adds. "Everyone has a love for music. It brings me joy to watch how the residents move and engage during the music sessions - it undoubtedly lifts their spirits."

In addition to these drop-in classes and private sessions, Swallow Hill provides further programming with partner organizations like **Developmental Pathways, Rocky Mountain Region VA Medical Center, the Alzheimer's Association, and various memory care centers.**

Our music therapy programs include onsite Musical Memories for individuals experiencing memory loss and their caregivers, as well as Musical Pathways classes designed for adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD). These free, drop-in classes use the transformative power of music to help increase overall brain function, encourage emotional awareness, evoke joy, and strengthen neural pathways.




