We expanded our revenue streams by adding talent-buying and booking services, event rentals, and fee-for-service programming to support our underwritten outreach programs.

We've continued our county expansion with concerts at Northglenn Arts and a brand new street festival in Englewood (Indiewood).

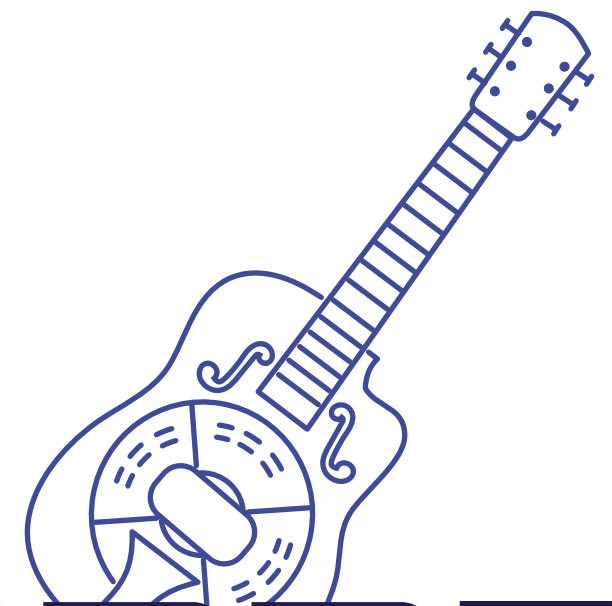

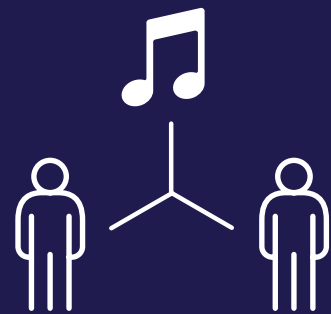

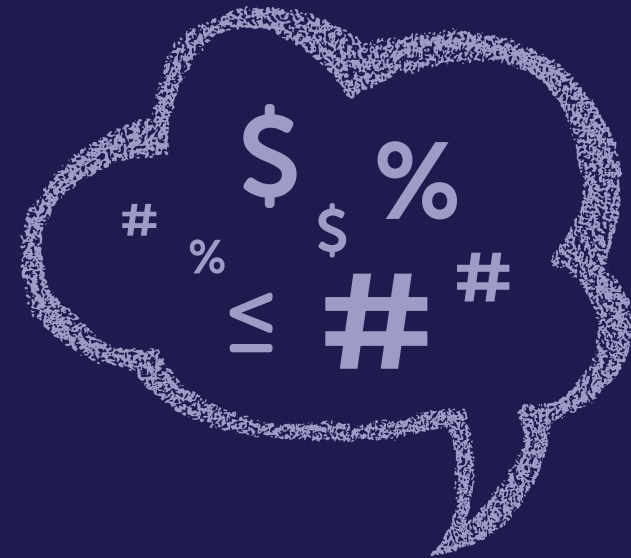

OUTREACH

Our Outreach programs are music experiences for all ages including Interactive Performances, Instrument Petting Zoos, Music Therapy, Enrichment Classes, and Group Workshops. These community-based programs continued to grow in meaningful ways throughout 2025, all of which strengthened our community relationships and expanded access to music, with more than 21,600 Musical Connections. Among the hundreds of programs we presented, a few stand out as especially meaningful.

Our partnership with Pine Lane Elementary, the largest elementary school in Douglas County, remains one of our most rewarding collaborations. Each year, we send our Instrument Petting Zoo and Harmonica Workshop to more than 100 first-grade students. The excitement from students and teachers, along with the repeat requests for Swallow Hill instructors Marcus Quintero and Nic Clark, reflects the positive impact these experiences create.

Our Songs & Sing Along program also continued to flourish. This traveling, interactive music workshop is designed for adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Through longstanding partnerships with ABLE Day Program and Nostalgia Group, we gather every other week to make music and celebrate self-expression.

This year also brought inspiring new collaborations. Through a Scientific & Cultural Facilities District (SCFD) collaboration grant, we partnered with the Children’s Museum to present The Lullaby Project, a Carnegie Hall initiative that empowers caregivers to write and record personal lullabies for their children. We also partnered with the African Leadership Group to support a youth ensemble, creating new opportunities for young musicians.

STREET FESTIVAL

In June 2025, we hosted our first street festival in more than five years. Produced in partnership with the City of Englewood, Indiewood sold out as hundreds gathered to listen, dance, and connect.

Our partnership with Northglenn Arts established recurring programming in Adams County, creating new opportunities to connect audiences through live performance. We were proud to start the series by welcoming acclaimed folk artist Tom Rush to the Parsons Theatre.

Advanced House of Rock Camp took their performance down the road to a packed house at the Hi-Dive! These talented teens worked hard to master and perform Rage Against the Machine's breakout, self-titled album from start to finish. Camp leader, Chadzilla, ensured their summer was filled with powerful musical growth, unforgettable memories, and a whole lot of rock!



AN EVENING WITH IRON & WINE

Our benefit concert series made its debut with a sold-out solo performance by Iron & Wine in Daniels Hall. Limited to just 250 attendees, the evening delivered a rare, intimate concert experience while raising funds to support our mission.

A TRIBUTE

Swallow Hill honored the lives of two members of our community, Brian Vogt and Jill Sobule. Brian's vision helped launch our partnership with the Denver Botanic Gardens back in 2010, creating a collaboration that enhanced our reach and impact. We also welcomed friends, family, and fans to celebrate Jill's life through stories and songs, a tribute to an artist and community member whose legacy continues to inspire us all.



10 Years! LITTLE Swallows

We celebrated the 10th anniversary of the highly successful Little Swallows early childhood music education program in 2025. As an integral part of our Community Outreach Programs, Little Swallows exemplifies our commitment to making music accessible for all.

The program uses songs, creative movement, rhymes, percussion instruments, and other fun musical activities to deepen preschoolers' educational development during their most formative years. Classes are led by our instructors, experienced musicians who capture the attention and imagination of students.

"It's a very playful program, it's very fun! The main idea (is) to make them feel well, to be in contact with music, to experience the music itself," Little Swallows Instructor Adolfo Romero explains with a smile.

What started as a pilot program at one school has grown over the years, and since its inception, Little Swallows has made more than an estimated 266,000 musical connections.

In 2025, we continued to demonstrate that dedication to fun and learning by providing Little Swallows at 34 partner schools, making 83,775 connections, with 80% of participants from low income households and students of color.

Music SCHOOL



95% of students at Swallow Hill said they would recommend Swallow Hill Music School to a friend.

In 2025, our Music School continued the trend of growth since 2023 in enrollment, program offerings, and instructors.

"Day to day, my awareness of how unique and silly and special and powerful this place is grows," School Director Tyler Breuer says. "And it's very warming to see it actually grow," he adds.

A great example of program growth being matched by its evolution can be found in our Summer Camps, where we teach Explore! Music Camp to students ages 6 to 10, and House of Rock, for students ranging in age from 11 to 18.

"What really struck me this year was the community that's developed around our summer camps," School Programs Manager Harry Todd says. "Our teachers bonded and supported each other in really lovely ways. We started the year in stride and kept that going!"

That supportive community among instructors and students carried over throughout the year, as witnessed by the growth in our group class recitals and student ensemble concerts.

"Seeing the growth in student performances is so rewarding - we're doing more of them because the school is getting bigger and we're adding those opportunities accordingly," School Programs Manager Catherine Cecil observes, adding, "I also think students and teachers are more and more committed to sharing their music with loved ones and the Swallow Hill community."

As a folk music institution, I'm proud of how teachers especially instill that sharing music with others is as fundamental, challenging, and rewarding as mastering new skills in the classroom."

Every concert is an opportunity to bring people joy and connection. In 2025, those moments happened again and again, as unforgettable performances and meaningful community partnerships helped us reach exciting new milestones.

Our concert growth was driven by community partnerships, expanded booking services, and increased ticket sales. Together, these efforts helped us present 219 concerts, including 187 performances at Swallow Hill and 32 concerts at partner sites throughout the Front Range. From intimate listening rooms to community stages, every performance connected artists and audiences in meaningful ways.

A highlight of the year was the launch of the **Indiewood Street Festival**, our first street festival in more than five years. Produced in partnership with the City of Englewood, the sold-out event

welcomed hundreds of attendees for the day-long musical celebration. We also expanded our reach through a new partnership with Northglenn Arts, launching recurring programming in Adams County with an acclaimed performance by **Tom Rush at the Parsons Theatre**.

We introduced our benefit concert series with a sold-out, intimate performance by **Iron & Wine**. This event raised funds for our mission while offering patrons a once-in-a-lifetime concert experience.

Whether on our own stages or alongside partners, this year's performances reflected the power of live music to inspire connection and strengthen communities.

Since joining Swallow Hill as our Volunteer Coordinator in 2021, Patty Jackson (a former volunteer herself) has grown the program to unparalleled levels in our history, making volunteers an indispensable part of our daily business in the process.

"Patrons experience a warm, welcoming presence from the volunteers from the minute they walk in the door for a show," Patty explains. "The volunteers are able to help the patrons navigate around the building and answer many patrons' questions."

Of course, for an organization that views building community as central to its mission, the volunteers get something from it too.

"Volunteers get a great feeling of connection to the mission and values of Swallow Hill," she adds. "They enjoy the connections and friendships with one another. They also get to see shows after their volunteer shift is completed."

And while you can't put a price on all those good vibes, it's nice that it does positively affect our bottom line to the tune of **5,569 volunteer hours worked** in 2025. That's roughly equivalent to 2 2/3 full-time employees - **resulting in \$215,743 in value** to the organization!

Swallow Hill's financial deficit is due to a one-time, non-cash write-off of \$334,427 from a closed capital building project alongside deliberate strategic investments in staffing and infrastructure. Backed by strong reserves and a disciplined long-term plan, the Board remains confident that these decisions will ensure the return to a balanced budget and the organization's long-term sustainability.

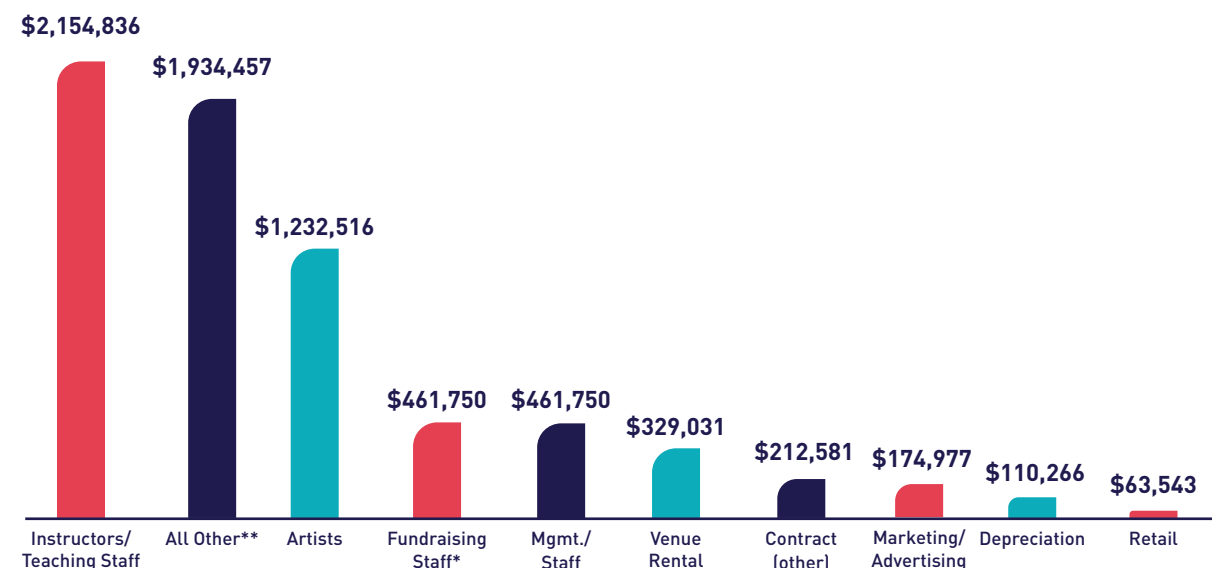

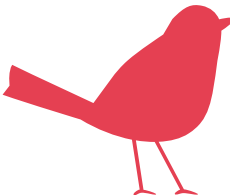

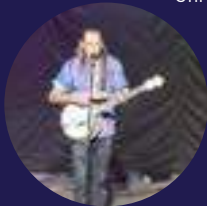
